## Re: Spring 2019 Election Complaints

We, the members of the CSEC, have completed investigations into all Spring 2019 Election complaints and provide the following notice of outcomes:

Complaints concerning misconduct of members of ISG:

CSEC does not have the jurisdiction to hold members of ISG accountable to any particular standard. The content of the complaint is recommended to be heard by the Office of Student Conduct and Resolution.

Complaints concerning slander between student trustee candidates:

Where applicable, CSEC holds the trustees responsible for the behavior of themselves and their respective party & campaign team. Individual student behavior is recommended to be heard by the appropriate university departments such as OSCR or BART.

Complaints concerning designated non-campaign location:

Designated non-campaign location policies are to be strictly enforced. Any campaign materials located in these areas are to be removed and candidates are reminded of their responsibility to ensure that they and their supporters follow these policies.

The CSEC concludes that all complaints have resulted in proper acknowledgement and appropriate adjudication as set forth by the powers given to the Commission. Because of the behaviors of this electoral season and through continued collaboration with our campus constituents, it is the belief of the CSEC that more attention needs to be given to the Election Code to best meet the expectations of the mission set forth by the Office of the Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs and all of our collaborative partners.

The CSEC and its advisory team remained committed to maintaining the integrity of the electoral process here at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign.
